Dear Parent/Carer

We hope you have had a lovely Easter break and that the children are excited to be back at school. We have got lots of exciting weekly themes coming up this term focusing on growing and enjoying nature! This booklet is to inform you of what your child will be learning this term. There are also some questions included to help your children to extend their learning at home.

Mathematics (M)

This term we will begin our maths learning with building numbers beyond 10. Children will learn how to recognise, order and represent numbers to 20 and that teen numbers are formed of 10 and another number. We will then look at patterns using shapes - learning how to match patterns and create our own.

Can you make your own shape picture?

Literacy (L)

In Literacy this half term, we are continuing to focus on writing sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We are going to start our term with a class favourite 'Rainbow Fish' where we will be using adjectives and exploring using the word 'and' to make our sentences even more exciting. We will be working hard to use our phonics skills to spell words using special friends and practise reading our sentences back to check that they make sense.

Can you choose your favourite story character and write a description about them?

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSED)

During this term we will be discussing how to share our feelings with those around us as well as exploring calming techniques when we are feeling a little angry or cross. Children will also be learning about the importance of a good night's sleep and how this keeps us healthy.

Can you write a list of things to do that help you to feel calm?

Communication and Language (CL)

This term we will be doing lots of speaking and listening activities as a whole class and in small groups. We will mainly be focusing on answering where and why questions and using full sentences.

Can you record yourself telling us where you would like to go on a day out and why?

Physical Development (PD)

In PE we will be doing athletics. This unit will see us try out lots of different sporting events including running, javelin, relay races, target throws and much much more. Lots of practise for our sports day which will happen later on this year. These sessions will continue to take place on a Thursday morning. Please send your child to school in their school PE kit on this day.

Can you make your own balancing obstacle course at home to complete?

Understanding the World (UTW)

In UTW we will be looking at the season of spring and discussing the typical weather that happens during this time. We will also be looking at what plants need to grow and having a go at growing our own bean plants. I wonder who's will grow the tallest...

Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

In EAD we are going to be developing our printing by moving onto mono-printing and creating our own patterns. We are also going to be looking at some art work by Georgia O'Keeffe and having a go at recreating some pieces too!
