Year 6 information for parents

Dear Parent/Carer,

This letter is intended to give you information regarding the last few weeks of term for our Year 6 pupils.

Monday 17th July – Wednesday 19th July – York residential

For those children who are going to York, they will need to be in school at the normal time and we will aim to be back by the end of the school day on Wednesday 19th July. Please follow Park Lane on Twitter for updates.

If your child is not attending the trip to York, they should come into school at the usual times where a member of staff will work with them on a whole project linked to recreation – creating games, creating drinks and other fun activities.

Monday 10th July – T-shirt signing

Please ensure that your child has a school shirt in school which can be signed, along with a newspaper. This will help when signing to prevent print going through to the other side.

Please write their name in large letters across the front of the shirt, then bring these into school in a named bag – they can be left in the child's locker. The shirts will be taken into the main hall where all the Year 6 children can sign the shirts, along with autograph books which the school will provide. Children will need to bring in their own marker pens to sign the shirt.

Thursday 13th July – Activity Day

We will be taking children to the pool for a splash party before returning to school to complete other activities. In the afternoon there will be an 'It's a Knockout' themed day where children will challenge each other in a range of activities. Please send children to school with their swimming kit and dressed in their P.E kit.

There will be a special lunch for Year 6 children in school – please pay for this on the school gateway (select Key Stage 2 Meals). We hope that this will be an enjoyable last lunch in the school hall.

Friday 14th July – last day in school

We will have a large screen brought into school and we will watch a film outside. Please send your child in with a garden chair that they can sit on. Popcorn, drinks, and other treats will be served.

For lunch we will order pizza from a local takeaway – we will attempt to cater for all needs.

Friday 14th July – Leavers assembly at 2.00pm

We would like to invite all Year 6 parents to St Mary's Church from 2.00pm – 3.00pm for a leaver's assembly. Here we will thank children and parents for their time at school and children will share a memory of their time here. We will finish by sharing the leaver's video that has been created. At the end of the assembly, you will be allowed to take your children home with you.
