Year 3 visit to Flag Fen – Tuesday 13th May 2025

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our summer term's work on 'Boudica's resistance to the Roman invasion of Britain' we are planning a visit to Flag Fen on Tuesday 13th May to learn about the end of the Celtic period and the transition to Roman Britain. The visit aims to enhance the children's classroom learning with a memorable and immersive experience.

The day is fully led by Flag Fen teachers who are all highly experienced, knowledgeable and have a passion for bringing history to life. There will be a range of activities throughout the day including meeting Boudica, learning to be a Roman detective and working with pottery.

We will leave school at 9.00am and will plan to return no later than 3.00pm, so children can be collected as normal at 3.15pm.

The cost of the visit will be £13.50. Payments need to be paid through the School Gateway app or online at www.schoolgateway.com by Tuesday 6th May. Please ensure you tick the consent box. If you have any problems with the system, please contact the school office. If you would prefer to pay by cash, please call into the office for a PayPoint voucher. Unfortunately, if not enough voluntary contributions are received, the trip may have to be cancelled.

Please ensure that your child has a packed lunch in a named plastic bag as these can be thrown away so the children will not have to carry lunchboxes all day. If your child is entitled to free school meals, please order this by entering the preferred choice of sandwich filling (ham, cheese, egg or tuna mayo) in the comments box when making payment.

Please also make sure that your child wears sensible shoes and has wellington boots in a named bag for exploring the site. They will also need to dress appropriately for the weather in school uniform and a raincoat.
