


Pippin has collected some sticks. Can you point to a long stick? Has Pippin found any sticks that aren't long?

Sam made a ramp for his toy cars to roll down. Which one rolled a long way? Did any only roll a short way?




Challenge Yourself:


- On a piece of paper, can you draw some long lines and some short lines?

Compare Length


longer longest shorter shortest

Look at all of the sticks that Pippin has collected! Lucy is measuring them with interlocking cubes. Which stick is the longest? Which is the shortest?




Challenge Yourself:




Rian has made 2 towers of bricks. Which tower is tall? Which tower is short?

Willow spotted some animals at the zoo. Can you describe them using the words 'tall' and 'short'?




- Use some building bricks to build a tall tower. Can you build a short tower too?




Mikalah has built some towers using wooden blocks. Can you describe them using the words 'tall', 'taller' and 'tallest'?




Victor spots 3 trees in the park. What do you notice? Which tree is the shortest?

Shantal is measuring the flowers in her garden using cubes. Can you find a flower that is taller than the yellow flower? Which flowers are shorter than the red flower?




Challenge Yourself:

- Have a look at the trees or flowers in your garden or at the park. Can you describe them using the words 'tall', 'taller' and 'tallest'?


Talk About Time


- Look at a calendar. What days and months can you see? What did you do last week? How about last month? What special events are coming up? When are they?

Order and Sequence Time




Teddy went on a walk and took photos of what he saw. Can you talk about Teddy's walk? What did he see first? What was the last thing he saw?
