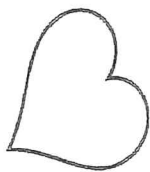
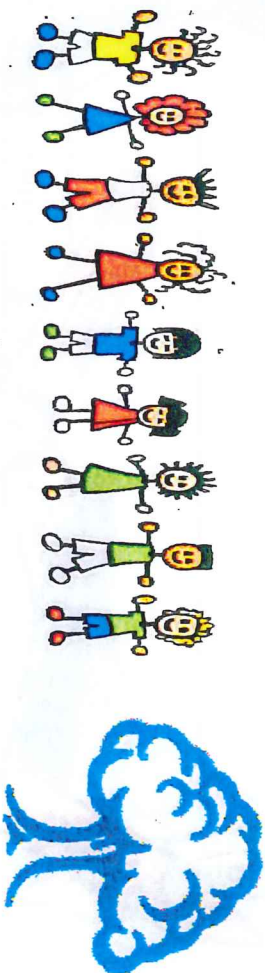
# Welcome to Park Lane Nursery

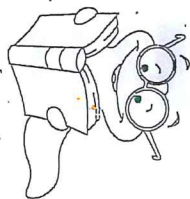
This booklet is designed to give you an opportunity to tell us about your child and to make the transition from home to Nursery as smooth as possible.

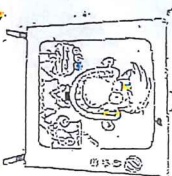
If you would like to make an All About Me box with your child please do so and bring the box to Nursery on your child's first day.



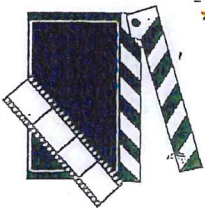
